The Midway was lively, the entertainment lineup packed crowds, and the grounds buzzed with activity and excitement.

ULTIMATE HOLIDAY PARTY DELIVERS A SOLD-OUT NIGHT OF CELEBRATION

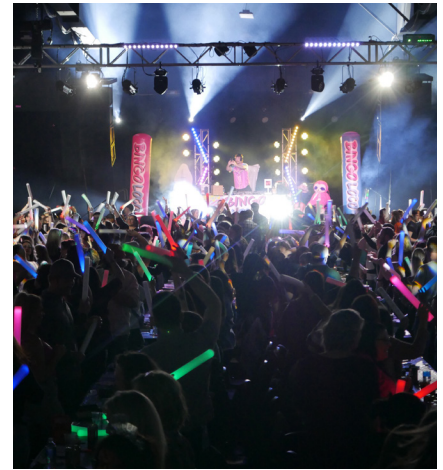

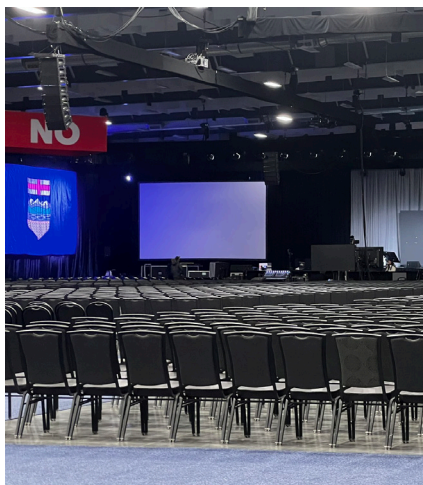


UCP ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING DRAWS THOUSANDS TO WESTERNER PARK

Agri-Trade Equipment Expo, presented by Farm Credit Canada, celebrated its 40th anniversary in 2024 with a landmark event that set new records and reaffirmed its role as a premier agricultural showcase. The show featured over 500 exhibitors across 300,000 sq. ft., including the largest outdoor exhibit area in its history and a sold-out indoor floor. Thousands of attendees explored cutting-edge equipment and innovations, with warm weather contributing to strong turnout and engagement.

Exhibitor feedback highlighted robust sales and valuable connections, reinforcing the show's business impact. The event featured participants from over a dozen countries, including Germany, Japan, and Australia. Agri-Trade also demonstrated its growing international reach and the global relevance of the Canadian ag market.



WESTERNER DAIRY SHOWCASE CELEBRATES 70 YEARS AND NATIONAL RECOGNITION

In October 2024, Westerner Park proudly celebrated the 70th anniversary of the Dairy Showcase. ALBERTA PORK CONGRESS MARKS 50 YEARS AT WESTERNER PARK

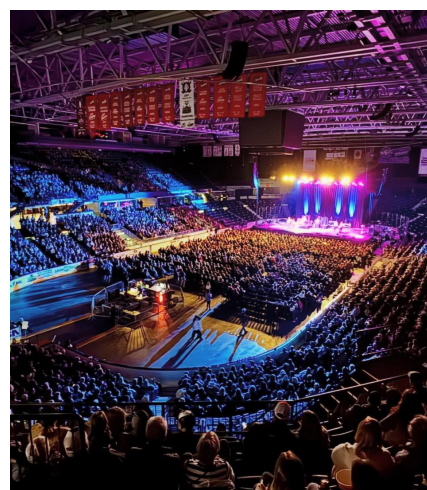

In October, Westerner Park hosted a high-energy concert featuring Sawyer Brown with Shenandoah and special guest George Fox. The event was one of only 49 scheduled concerts across the country last year, making it a standout night for Central Alberta music fans. COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

In 2024, we kickstarted our renewed commitment to community outreach, laying the foundation for an even more active role in 2025. From supporting local causes to encouraging team involvement, our goal is to build meaningful connections across Central Alberta.

We participated in events like the Hope Mission Back to School BBQ and the annual Christmas volunteer initiative, both of which saw strong engagement from our team.

Additionally, a number of team members independently volunteered at Sight Night, a unique after-dark fun-run fundraiser that levels the playing field between sighted and visually impaired participants. Other Highlights

This year has been filled with notable advancements for Westerner Park, and we're proud to share several key achievements that reflect our ongoing commitment to growth, innovation, and community impact.

WESTERNER PARK RV RESORT – A STRATEGIC STEP FORWARD

We are pleased to announce that Westerner Park has officially assumed management of the Westerner Campground, now known as the Westerner Park RV Resort. This expansion strengthens our operational capacity and broadens the range of services we offer—from accommodating guests attending horse shows, dog shows, and Westerner Days, to providing a welcoming space for travelers.

Bringing the Westerner Park RV Resort under our management supports a seamless and elevated experience for all visitors while optimizing the value of our assets.

Our dedication to maintaining the highest standards of service remains unwavering, and thanks to the hard work of our team, Westerner Park is now unified, strategically positioned, and prepared for long-term success.

ICE PLANT OVERHAUL ON TRACK

The \$1.5 million ice plant replacement project is on track, with equal funding from the Community Facility Enhancement Program (Government of Alberta) and the Westerner Foundation. The contract was awarded in October 2024, and construction begins this spring. Located at the southeast corner of the Centrium, the new plant will be fully operational in time for the 2025 Rebels season.

NORTHERN REGIONAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GRANT – PROJECT COMPLETE

The Northern Regional Economic Development Grant project has been completed, with the installation of new signage now fully operational throughout the park. This upgrade injects new energy into Westerner Park, enhancing visitor navigation and providing clear directions to events, attractions, and services.

The new signage also increases visibility for upcoming events, sponsors, and attractions, fostering greater awareness and deeper community engagement. These enhancements contribute to a more modern and cohesive brand image, ultimately enriching the guest experience and supporting the continued growth of Westerner Park.

AGSMART EDUCATIONAL EXPO TRANSITION

In 2024, AgSmart officially transitioned to the Agri-Trade Equipment Expo group through an agreement between Olds College of Agriculture & Technology and Agri-Trade. This strategic move marked a new chapter for the event, which has long been recognized for advancing agricultural innovation and education. While Agri-Trade takes on the leadership of the event, AgSmart will continue to be hosted at Olds College, ensuring continuity in location while expanding its reach and industry impact. The Expo remains a vital platform for learning, technology, and collaboration in the agriculture sector.

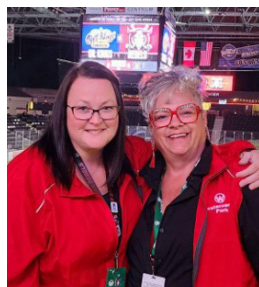
