

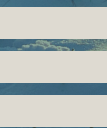

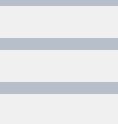

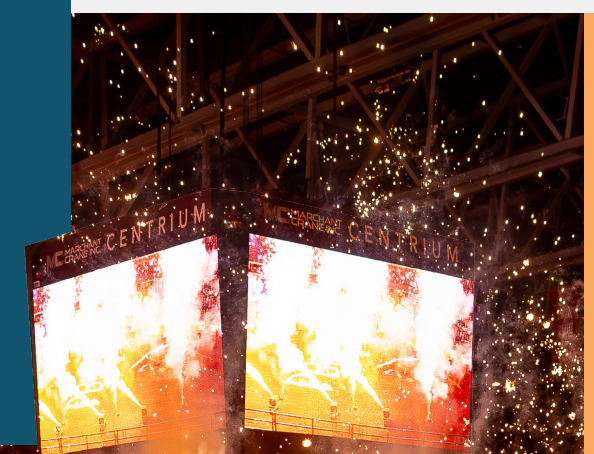

Marchant Crane Centrium Investing in Community Connection

This year, Westerner Park proudly unveiled the Marchant Crane Centrium, marking a significant investment in the future of sport, entertainment, and community gathering in Central Alberta.

The partnership reflects a shared commitment to building strong communities and creating spaces where people can come together to compete, celebrate, and connect. Rooted in local values and community pride, Marchant Crane's investment demonstrates the important role partnerships play in ensuring Westerner Park continues to serve the region for generations to come.

More than a naming partnership, the Marchant Crane Centrium represents a shared belief in the power of community and the importance of investing in places that bring people together. It stands as a testament to what can be achieved when local businesses choose to support the future of their community.



Westerner Days Community Tradition in Motion

For generations, Westerner Days has brought Central Alberta together through shared experiences, celebration, and community pride. In 2025, that tradition continued as more than 45,000 guests came through the gates for five days of entertainment, agriculture, midway excitement, music, and connection.

This year's event featured 34 midway rides, 46 market vendors, 115 parade entries, 42 corporate partners, 30 musicians and entertainers, and 60 chuckwagon and chariot participants.

One of the year's most memorable highlights was the return of the RCMP Musical Ride, which welcomed more than 7,000 attendees across five performances. Extending the spirit of Westerner Days beyond the fairgrounds, members of the RCMP Musical Ride and members of our entertainment lineup also visited Ronald McDonald House Charities Alberta, bringing smiles and special moments to children and families receiving care.

Community participation remained at the heart of the celebration. More than 450 children and youth from Red Deer Public Schools submitted entries to the annual colouring contest, showcasing their creativity and excitement for the fair. The return of the Share the Fair program helped make the event more accessible for local families, while more than 20 community pancake breakfasts created opportunities for neighbours, businesses, and visitors to connect throughout the city.

In partnership with Tourism Red Deer, Westerner Park also launched a new Attraction Pass, encouraging residents and visitors alike to explore local attractions and experiences. More than 400 participants signed up, helping strengthen connections across the region's tourism sector.

Behind the scenes, 90 volunteers contributed more than 1,164 hours across 211 shifts, demonstrating the incredible community commitment that continues to power Westerner Days year after year.

Westerner Days remains more than a summer event. It is a tradition deeply woven into the identity of Central Alberta, creating memories, strengthening community connections, and celebrating the people and organizations that make this region special.



Community Investment In Action

Strengthening the Future of Westerner Days

This year, community partners rallied behind Westerner Days through a significant contribution toward improvements to the chuckwagon track. The project reflects a shared commitment to preserving one of Central Alberta's most celebrated traditions while ensuring future generations can continue to experience the excitement and heritage of chuckwagon racing.



Westerner Rally for Cars And Kids Building New Traditions

This year marked the launch of the inaugural Westerner Rally for Cars & Kids, a new community event created through the leadership of the Westerner Foundation and the support of volunteers, sponsors, drivers, and community partners.

More than a showcase of remarkable vehicles, the Rally was designed to create meaningful experiences for local children and families. One of the event's most memorable features was the opportunity for young participants to serve as special co-pilots, riding alongside drivers throughout the rally and experiencing a day many will never forget.

The event brought together automotive enthusiasts from across the region who generously shared not only their vehicles, but also their time, passion, and commitment to supporting the community. From luxury

and performance vehicles to unique collector cars, the Rally created opportunities for connection while raising awareness and support for the Westerner Foundation's ongoing work.

While the first Rally for Cars & Kids was a tremendous success, it also marked the beginning of something larger. The event is already evolving, with exciting plans for its future as it continues to grow into a signature community tradition for Westerner Park and the Westerner Foundation.

As a first-year event, the Rally reflected the very spirit of Westerner Park: community built, impact driven, and always looking toward new opportunities to create meaningful experiences for the people we serve.



Agri-Trade Equipment Expo Driving Agriculture Forward

Agri-Trade Equipment Expo continued to reinforce Westerner Park's role as one of Canada's premier agricultural event destinations. Welcoming 30,235 attendees and 564 exhibitors, the 2025 show brought together producers, manufacturers, innovators, and agricultural leaders for three days of business, connection, and industry advancement.

This year's show featured the largest outdoor exhibit area in Agri-Trade history, sold-out indoor space, and more than 300,000 square feet of exhibits showcasing the latest equipment, technology, and agricultural innovation.

Agri-Trade also welcomed visitors and exhibitors from around the world, including Australia, China, Germany, Northern Ireland, Nigeria, the Philippines, Japan, Mexico, the United Kingdom, and the United States. This international presence demonstrated the growing global interest in Canadian agriculture and the continued strength of Central Alberta as a hub for agricultural business and innovation.

Agri-Trade continues to generate approximately \$300 million annually in sales for Alberta and Canadian manufacturers while strengthening industry relationships and creating opportunities for education, collaboration, and business growth.



Skijoring Westerner Park

Where Winter Meets Western

This year, Westerner Park partnered with Skijor Alberta to host the inaugural Westerner Park Skijoring event, bringing a uniquely Alberta blend of western heritage, winter sport, and community celebration to Central Alberta.

Spectators gathered to watch skilled riders and skiers team up to navigate a course featuring jumps, obstacles, and high-speed action. Throughout the day, guests enjoyed food trucks, local vendors, refreshments, and family-friendly activities, creating a vibrant festival atmosphere across the grounds.

The event's western flair was on full display as participants and guests embraced creative costumes, furs, and cowboy-inspired attire, adding to the unique character of the experience.

As a free community event, Skijoring introduced new audiences to the park while showcasing its ability to host unique year-round experiences. The success of the inaugural event highlighted the community's enthusiasm for unique year-round experiences and demonstrated the potential for Skijoring to become a new winter tradition at Westerner Park.



Red Deer Rebels A Tradition That Brings the Community Together

The Red Deer Rebels continued to create unforgettable moments at the Marchant Crane Centrium throughout the season, bringing together fans, families, and hockey supporters from across Central Alberta.

This year also marked a major milestone with the completion of the new ice plant at the Marchant Crane Centrium, ensuring the long-term sustainability of the facility while improving reliability and energy efficiency.

Country Throwdown brought country music fans together for a high-energy night of live entertainment and western spirit at Westerner Park.

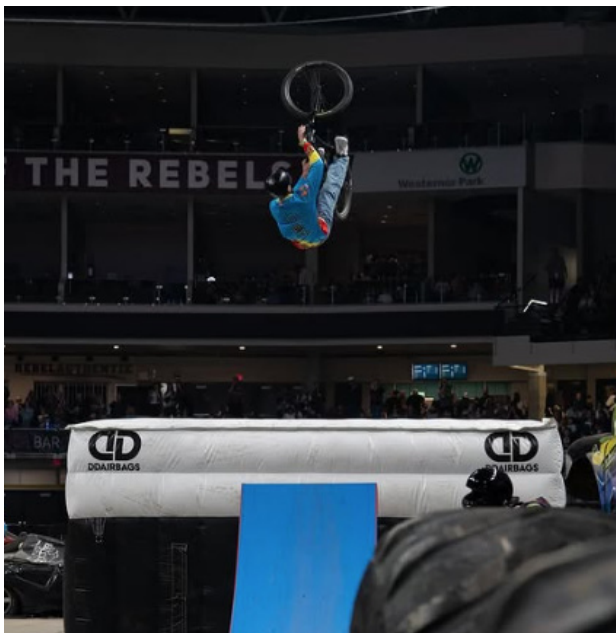

Investing In The Future

This year marked significant investments in the long-term sustainability and growth of Westerner Park. Through the support of government, industry, and community partners, funding was secured to strengthen organizational capacity, enhance facilities, support tourism and cultural initiatives, and position Westerner Park for future success.

A key investment this year was the \$850,000 grant from Alberta's Ministry of Agriculture and Irrigation. The funding was provided for specific organizational initiatives, including asset management planning, governance training, insurance, and utilities, helping strengthen Westerner Park's long-term sustainability and operational resilience. Investments like these ensure the organization remains well-positioned to serve the community today and into the future.

Additional funding received throughout the year included:

- Minister of Agriculture & Irrigation Grant: \$850,000
- Community Facility Enhancement Program Large: Stage, Sound & Lift Upgrades: \$171,146
- City of Red Deer Community Culture Development Fund: \$10,000
- Community Initiatives Program Project-Based: \$75,000
- Keyera: \$5,000
- Travel Alberta: \$30,000
- Tourism Red Deer: \$15,000
- UFA: \$1,00

Together, these investments strengthen Westerner Park's ability to serve the community, support agriculture, enhance guest experiences, and maintain the facilities and programs that contribute to Central Alberta's economic and social vitality

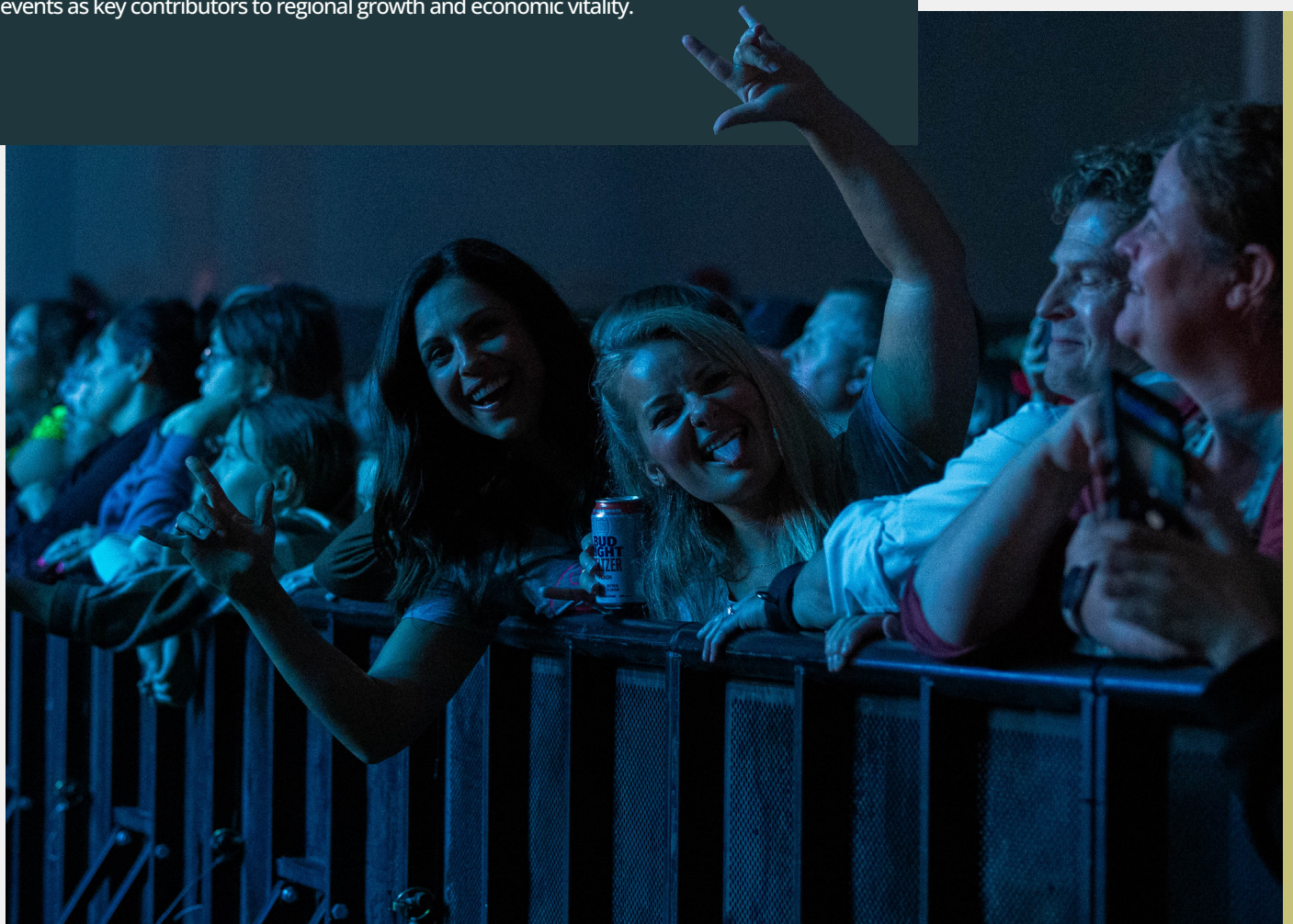
